



Graduates of the IACP Fellowships are equipped to:

• Fellowship in Sports Physiotherapy

- Work as Sports Team Physiotherapists, Athletic Rehabilitation Specialists, or Consultant Physiotherapists.
 - Pursue academic and research opportunities in allied health institutions.
 - Establish private practices focused on sports rehabilitation and injury prevention.

• Fellowship in Neurological Rehabilitation

- Work as a neuro-rehabilitation expert managing conditions like stroke, spinal cord injuries, and Parkinson's disease in hospitals or private neuro clinics.
 - Conduct advanced research in neuroplasticity, rehab technology, or evidence-based neuro-rehab, contributing to scientific publications and innovation.
 - Serve as a faculty or trainer in neuro-rehabilitation, develop curriculum, and guide students and professionals in advanced neurophysiotherapy practices.

Prospects and Future

Fellowship in Orthopedic Manual Therapy

- Orthopedic Manual Therapy Expert: Specialize in treating musculoskeletal disorders like back pain, joint dysfunctions, and sports injuries using hands-on techniques in hospitals, clinics, or private practice.
 - Significantly Clinical Researcher: Engage in research on manual therapy techniques, biomechanics, and pain science; contribute to evidence-based protocols and publish in peer-reviewed journals.
 - Academic & Skill Trainer: Teach orthopedic manual therapy in academic settings, conduct workshops and certifications, and mentor budding physiotherapists in hands-on therapeutic skills.

• Fellowship in Pediatric Physiotherapy

- Pediatric Rehab Specialist: Work with children having developmental delays, cerebral palsy, muscular dystrophy, and other pediatric conditions in hospitals, therapy centers, or early intervention clinics.
 - Research & Innovation: Conduct research on child development, motor learning, and pediatric intervention techniques; contribute to pediatric care guidelines and evidence-based practices.
 - Educator & Trainer: Take up teaching roles in physiotherapy colleges, lead workshops and seminars on pediatric rehab, and mentor students or junior therapists in pediatric physiotherapy.

Eligibility Criteria

- To qualify for admission, applicants must meet one of the following criteria:
- MPT holders with at least 2 years of post-graduation experience.
- **BPT holders** with at least 5 years of post-graduation experience.
- Additionally, **two recommendation letters** from practicing physiotherapists are required.

Fellowship Duration

• Total Duration: 6 months (self-paced)

Includes time for research, independent study, and thesis submission.

Fellowship Fees

• 35,000 INR

Admission Process

- Application Submission: Complete the application form and submit required documents.
- Verification of Documents: IACP verifies the applicant's credentials.
- Enrollment Confirmation & Fee Payment:

- Research Topic Proposal:
 Submit five proposed research topics for review.
- Topic Selection:
 IACP selects one approved topic for the fellowship thesis.
